We're Here For You.

As a result of collective bargaining, health and welfare benefits for non-Medicare retirees and the non-Medicare dependents of retirees under the FELRA & UFCW Retiree Health and Welfare Plan will end December 31, 2015. Instead, non-Medicare retirees and non-Medicare dependents will be eligible for a \$350 monthly stipend from the Fund's new Retiree Assistance Program (there is a limit of one stipend per household).
